### YOUR SUPPORT IMPROVED **QUALITY SERVICES**

During 2021-2022, CPC made a significant impact on quality educational services for Grant County's young children and their families. CPC's efforts to improve early childhood education (ECE) include the following:

- Formed an **early childhood Coalition** expanding local community partnerships and resources.
- Established a **Family Leadership Team (FLT)** to give voice to our local families as change agents.
- Developed and disseminated a **Community Assessment**.
- Partnered with local entities to create a newly piloted **after-school care program**.
- Supported new **home-based childcare** businesses.
- Collaborated with **ancillary support services**, early intervention, and home visitation.
- Increased local ECE **workforce opportunities**.

### CPC's 2022 NEEDS-BASED Community Assessment

CPC's Coalition and other partners collaborate to assess community needs and identify barriers and solutions leading to ECE program improvement efforts. Family, community, business, and ECE provider needs are essential in defining CPC's Vision and determining each goal and objective of the annual Strategic Plan. The 2022 Assessment results provided data and direction for ECE expansion to meet the needs of families and impact local economic development.



### YOUR SUPPORT HELPS MEET GROWING FISCAL NEEDS


100% of CPC's funds come from state and local grants, private donations, and membership fees. As a non-profit organization, CPC leverages all funds to broaden its impact on young children and their families.
